

# FREIGHT LABELING MADE SIMPLE



At Estes, we are committed to getting your freight where it needs to go, when it needs to get there. And accurately [labeling your freight](#) is one of the best ways to ensure your shipment gets from its origin to its destination without delays.



## Required details to include on your shipping labels:

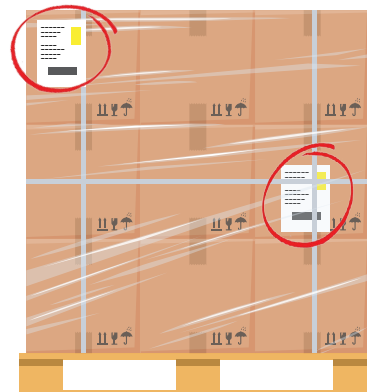
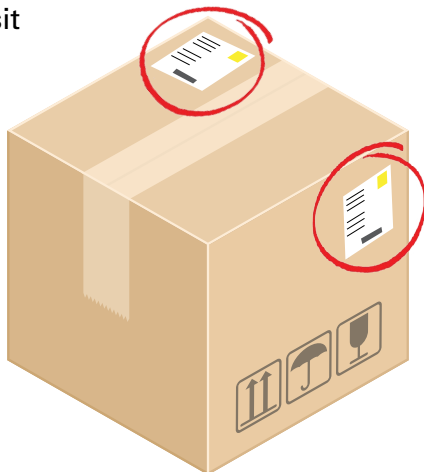
- » **PRO number** - Used to track your shipment, usually 10 digits long
- » **Consignee address** – Include street, city, state, and zip code
- » **Time Critical Guaranteed** service (if applicable)

And if you are shipping multiple handling units, please write the quantity on each unit's shipping label, such as 1 of 2 and 2 of 2.

**Note:** Including a **reference number** like a Shipment ID, BOL, or PO number can also help us move your freight more efficiently.

## Where to place your shipping labels:

- » **On the sides and top of your freight** - Ensures quick visibility from multiple angles, especially if stacked
- » **On the inside and outside of the pallet wrap** - Outer label allows for easy scanning, while the inner label ensures freight details remain visible, even if the wrap should get torn or ripped in transit

## How To Print Shipping Labels After Submitting Your eBOL

From your My Estes account:

- » On the BOL confirmation screen, select the **Print Shipping Labels** option
- » Choose your preferred label size and enter your label quantity
- » View your shipping label, check that the details are correct, and then select print
